CUFA would like to thank BT&PS for their generosity in donating the proceeds of their laptop sales to CUFA's Timor Leste project.



You may remember BTS sending out a notification a few months ago advertising old laptops for sale. This was part of their annual refresh program, whereby once a Cuscal laptop reaches three years, it is replaced with a new one. The old ones are then offered for sale to employees.

BTS had 19 laptops in total, which they sold for between \$100 - \$150. The proceeds of the sales were then donated to CUFA.

We would like to thank **Angela Donohoe, Michael Magoulis** and **Stephen Dorman**, as well as all **BTS** for putting in the work in selling the laptops. They raised \$2,600, which will go towards helping set up the Timor Leste project.

This project seeks to strengthen existing credit unions and the credit union federation in Timor Leste by providing training and field support. The eventual goal of the project is to bring credit unions to a point of sustainability through increasing membership and savings.
